



# FLORIDA COLLEGE ALABAMA CAMP

## CODE OF CONDUCT

Like Florida College, FC Alabama Camp sets a high standard for camper moral behavior. The following rules, while man-made, are based on scriptural principles and the need for structure, consistency and safety.

### DRESS CODE

*"...dressing 'modestly and discreetly'—1 Timothy 2:9*

- Clothing should not display indecent logos or messages
- "Pajama pants" are not appropriate except in one's cabin.
- Body piercing is not acceptable. The only exception is women's earrings.
- Men may not wear earrings or similar jewelry
- Shoes must be worn at all times, except in cabins.
- Boys are not to wear sleeveless shirts, except when swimming.
- Women's clothing should include proper undergarments and should not be tight-fitting nor revealing

#### **Prohibited clothing includes:**

- Halters, tank tops, or blouses showing the midriff
- Backless or low-cut dresses
- Low hip-hugger pants
- Skirts or shorts that do not touch the kneecap
- Skirts slit above the kneecap
- Leggings, yoga pants, Jeggings and tight jeans

### RESPECT FOR PROPERTY

*"He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good..." (Ephesians 4:28)*

- Campers are expected to respect the personal property of others.
- Theft will not be tolerated.
- Respect for camp property is expected.
- A camper will be held responsible for damages incurred to camp property or to another's personal property.

### INDIVIDUAL HONESTY

*"...Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices" (Colossians 3:9).*

- Campers are expected to be fully honest in their individual relationships and communications among themselves, as well as with camp staff.
- Lying will not be tolerated.

### OTHER BEHAVIORAL RULES

- The use of profanity or abusive speech is strictly prohibited
- Harassment of any kind is not acceptable. Harassment is defined as any physical or verbal abuse that is offensive to the recipient.
- The use of tobacco, alcohol & drugs will not be tolerated.
- Prescription drugs must be dispensed by camp nursing staff and may not be kept in camper's possession.
- The use of electronic devices is prohibited during camp. Electronic devices include cell phones, tablets, laptops, radios, portable speakers and MP3 players. Electronic devices will be confiscated and returned at the end of camp.
- Possession of firearms, knives, fireworks or explosives is prohibited.
- All campers are expected to abide by all camp staff instruction during the week of camp.
- Any requested exception to any camp rule must be cleared with the camp director prior to camp.
- The purpose of the Camp Code of Conduct is to ensure camp safety, promote spiritual growth as well as to provide the basis for lifetime friendships.
- Campers are encouraged to make friends among both genders, but all behavior must be conducive to purity.
- Public display of affection is not allowed while camp is in session.
- All rules and instructions given to campers are to be followed.
- Campers are expected to stay in approved and designated areas.
- Campers will not be allowed off the campground during the duration of camp.

This Code of Conduct contains general rules governing behavior at Florida College Alabama Camps and may be modified or amended at the discretion of camp leadership.
